IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Lead Treatment Technique Requirements Not Met

Our water system recently violated a drinking water requirement. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did (are doing) to correct this situation.

Failure to meet minimum treatment requirements for lead has the potential to increase your exposure to lead. We did not complete the following requirement(s):

Requirement(s) not met: Failure to develop and submit by the deadline the initial Lead and Service Line Inventory and failure to make initial lead Service line Inventory Publicly Accessible.

Period(s) of Non-Compliance: October 17, 2024, through November 14, 2024

There is no safe level of lead in drinking water. Exposure to lead in drinking water can cause serious health effects in all age groups, especially pregnant people, infants (both formula-fed and breastfed), and young children. Some of the health effects to infants and children include decreases in IQ and attention span. Lead exposure can also result in new or worsened learning and behavior problems. The children of persons who are exposed to lead before or during pregnancy may be at increased risk of these harmful health effects. Adults have increased risks of heart disease, high blood pressure, kidney or nervous system problems. Contact your health care provider for more information about your risks.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. We will notify you within 24 hours if a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink.

What is being done?

The Bluff Dale Water Supply Corporation recently failed to meet lead treatment requirements by not submitting the initial Lead and Service Line Inventory on time and not making it publicly accessible. This violation is not an emergency, but it could increase exposure to lead in drinking water, which poses serious health risks, especially for pregnant people, infants, young children, and adults. The water system has corrected the violation by completing and submitting the inventory, and it continues to work with customers to identify service line materials to ensure compliance and protect public health.

- **Lead treatment violation details:** The water system failed to develop and submitted the initial Lead and Service Line Inventory by the deadline and did not make it publicly accessible as required.
- **Health risks from lead exposure:** Lead in drinking water can cause serious health effects, including decreased IQ and attention span in children, learning and behavior problems, and increased risks of heart disease and kidney issues in adults.
- **Corrective actions and ongoing efforts:** The inventory has been completed, submitted, and accepted by TCEQ. The water system is continuing to gather information from customers

about service line materials to prevent lead contamination and will report findings yearly until all unknown line materials are identified.
